Over 25 years ago, a motorcycle crash changed Al Foxx from a healthy 19-year old roofer to a disability survivor with brain damage and partial paralysis. This life-changing event launched him on a painfully slow but rewarding rehabilitation journey that transformed him into an understanding and enthusiastic spokesperson and professional speaker on the topics of ***Winners Don't Quit, Delighting in Difference***, and ***Disabling Disability Myths***. His storytelling ability and contagious believe-in-possibilities philosophy brings laughter and hope to all ages.

Al Foxx is also the Founder and President of the Winners Don't Quit Association. It is the mission of WDQA to promote disability awareness, countering the myths concerning those who have disabilities and to encourage people with or without disabilities to make winning choices, regardless of their circumstances. He has been chosen to speak at Pathfinder Services, Inc.'s Annual recognition dinner on Saturday, November 8th about how he has overcome his disability to live a successful life.

Foxx recently published his life story in the book, No Limits. Copies of No Limits will be available to purchase at the event for \$15.00, and Foxx will be happy to sign purchased copies. All books purchased at the book signing must be paid for in cash, no checks or credit cards will be accepted.
