Pathfinder Community Supports is the adult and teen services division of Pathfinder Services and began impacting lives in 1966.

Group Home Living

Group Home Living provided by Pathfinder Community Supports offers 24 hour care. Group homes have a family environment involving residents in the community with a registered nurse available if needed.

Supported Independent Living

Supported Independent Living provided by Pathfinder Community Supports offers one to 24 hours of assistance based on the individuals needs. The program encourages self-sufficiency through providing choice and control over destiny. Supported Independent Living builds life skills with staff support as needed.

Day Services

Day Services provided by Pathfinder Community Supports encourages the individuals served to participate in the community. We build social skills, focus on individual goal development and take life experience trips.

Teen Programs

Teen Programs provided by Pathfinder Community Supports include a Before and After School Program for teens, Summer Enrichment Camps and Teens on the Town, a recreational program for teens.

Respite Care

Provides caregiver relief for parents or guardians of individuals being served by Pathfinder Community Supports.

Person Centered Planning*

Encourages individuals to identify their personal interests and dreams. Caring staff help develop skills and resources to fulfill goals set to achieve their interests and dreams.

Client Transportation*

Individuals receiving group home or supported independent living services are provided transportation for their various needs.
